WLP001 - California Ale Yeast 1.016	strong-ish bitterness, clean, fruity, crisp little to no hop aroma a bit hazy
WLP002 - English Ale Yeast 1.020	smoother + rounder, malt flavors come through better more well-balanced, slight apricot/cinnamon aroma nice fruitiness
WLP004 - Irish Ale Yeast 1.010	lemony flavor/aroma, grapefruit rind flavor w/ some maltiness sharp character
WLP005 - British Ale Yeast 1.019	more of a lingering bitterness - grapefruit finish nicely balanced, bitterness is lingering, more than others creamy maltiness
WLP007 - Dry English Ale Yeast 1.019	slight phenolic aroma, much less bitter, but w/ lingering bitterness doesn't seem dry. One of the most balanced. light hop aroma spicier flavor
WLP008 - East Coast Ale Yeast 1.017	dry but not as stark as California. drier flavor, malt lost angular, bitterness comes through, fairly neutral a bit,
WLP009 - Australian Ale Yeast 1.017	Belgian, fruity aroma, w/ hint of apricot very round + well-balanced "banana skin" + apricot
WLP011 - European Ale 1.016	subtly aromatic taste almost vegetal (broccoli?) malt is foundation but not flavor, hop character is gone.
WLP028 - Edinburgh Scottish Ale Yeast 1.019	nice spicy aroma, smooth malty character bit of a caramel flavor, slightly sweeter

1.016	sulfury, fruit aroma (passionfruit), good balance of malt + lingering bitterness olive notes bit of honey?
WLP051 - California Ale V Yeast	
1.017	not balanced, very fruity w/ cardboard-y note? but not oxidized. something is amiss. potential unsanitized carboy?
WLP060 - American Ale Blend	
1.016	clean, slightly nappy aroma. (putty-like aroma?) a bit sharp taste is breadly, sweet but dry. honey component? sulfur components malt of yeast.
WLP080 - Cream Ale Yeast	
1.017	clean, crisp, "kolsch-ish" - little bit of sulfur mild, bitterness is subdued. hop flavor is present + good bread in finish?
WLP500 - Trappist Ale	
1.016	gassy aroma sulfur notes, no x + base don't match. herb-y, spicy! sweet but no bubblegum taste.
WLP550 - Belgian Ale Yeast	
<del>1.016</del> 1.016	acetaldehyde aroma (present but not strong) flavor leans toward fruit end of spectrum. subdued spiciness. from low fermentation temp. acetaldehyde could come (other key that was fermenting @ correct temp was good though)
WLP565 - Belgian Saison Yeast	
Dille 1.023	not offensive or pleasing in any way. phenol, sweet, a little smoky, but not over mouthfeel the top. hot a lot of saison characteristics
WLP810 - San Francisco Lager Yeast	
1.017	sulfur, "racing kitty" aroma. flavor is clean + crisp flavor is much better than nose. was "European lager nose" nice hop expression - tastes more noble than cascade or amarillo
WLP862 - Cry Havoc	
1.017	green apple, acetaldehyde aroma. tropical fruit (red currant?) in flavor. weird - lychee? olive-like character.

WLP001 - California Ale Yeast		Hazy, light malty no hop aroma nice spicy citrusy hop flavor. good bitterness (high) full bitter flavor upfront. clean bitterness
WLP002 - English Ale Yeast	*	Bready, biscuity, hazzy, far less hop bitterness perception up front, little asparagus in the middle, light fruit taste. good head retention. softer, milder. moderate hop
WLP004 - Irish Ale Yeast		noticeably diff. nose - hint of sulphur. apricot hazzy - fruity. less bitter than cal. coo. apple, plum lower hop flavor
WLP005 - British Ale Yeast		Clean, fruit, light malt aroma, apricot bitterness upfront, fades quickly, mouth feel enhanced.
WLP007 - Dry English Ale Yeast		Much less bitter, thin mouthfeel perception, short bitterness upfront, but lingering nice mouthfeel, less zesty, low aromatics relatively uninteresting
WLP008 - East Coast Ale Yeast	*	agony vague maltness smooth, light fruitiness, hop flavor the most pronounced of sample so far, lighter perceived bitterness
WLP009 - Australian Ale Yeast	*	Malt aroma bread crust + banana, berries fruits flavor, hop flavor is medium. hop balanced, ester/fruits linger. easy drinking
WLP011 - European Ale		Hop aromas perceivable, malt flavor aroma pronounced apricot aroma bright hop flavor, more of the presence of the amaro and the maltie flavor the other 2 one of the favorites so far
WLP028 - Edinburgh Scottish Ale Yeast		good hop + malt aroma, light fruit malty finish lot of hop flavor, malty aroma pronounced fruit esters
WLP029 - German Ale/Kolsch Yeast		light sulphur amaro apricot aroma decent bitterness upfront, light sulphur and spice flavor, dry, not much malt flavor, least "interesting" flavor against the recipe/sty-2
